I would like to bring to your attention the absence in the book of the School's Safety Programme run by Mr. Jack O'Brien and a committee of apprentices. The safety figures were recorded on a notice board at the entrance to the School. 1967 showed a total of 250,000 man-hours free from lost-time injury. By 1972 the total had grown to 500,000 man-hours free from lost-time injury. This effort was rewarded by the presentation of a plaque from the Deputy Director.
