HUMS2009 TIMETABLE

A pdf version of the current preliminary HUMS2009 timetable is available from the HUMS2009 website under "Attachments". The full Congress Timetable, including this timetable and those for the other conferences (***Thirteenth Australian Aeronautical Conference, Seventh Australian Pacific Vertiflite Conference on Helicopter Technology, Third Australasian Unmanned Air Vehicles Conference***), will be available from the AIAC13 website.

Please note that this HUMS2009 timetable shows the Congress Plenary sessions, the two HUMS streams and the initial HUMS sessions at the Air Show venue. However, as Congress registrants, you may attend sessions at any of the concurrent Conferences. There are a few spare slots in the program (mainly on Thursday) but the papers offered cover HUMS in great depth and I'm sure we'll have a great conference.

If you do have a demonstration you can offer on the Thursday, please let us know. Thursday is part of the HUMS conference so presenters are normally either AIAC delegates or Airshow Exhibitors. We expect to confirm all the Thursday sessions by early in February. Presenters will have a screen and projector but will need to arrange a notebook PC and any other hardware needed for the demo. [This differs from Tuesday and Wednesday where the presentations will be pre-loaded onto the network.]

We can not guarantee that any specific paper will be presented at the time shown in this timetable, or at all, as presenters are only now confirming this schedule suits them.

REGISTRATION

Everyone who attends must register - see www.aiac13.com and click on the registration tab. Registration and accommodation booking should be conducted as soon as possible as accommodation options tend to become more difficult close to the conference. These are best done from the website (www.aiac13.com) but it is possible to download the registration form and then fax that. Make sure you select your conference of prime interest when completing either version of the form.

Even those entitled to free registration, such as sponsor representatives, must register - tick box on form or on web version.
